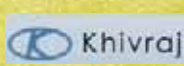

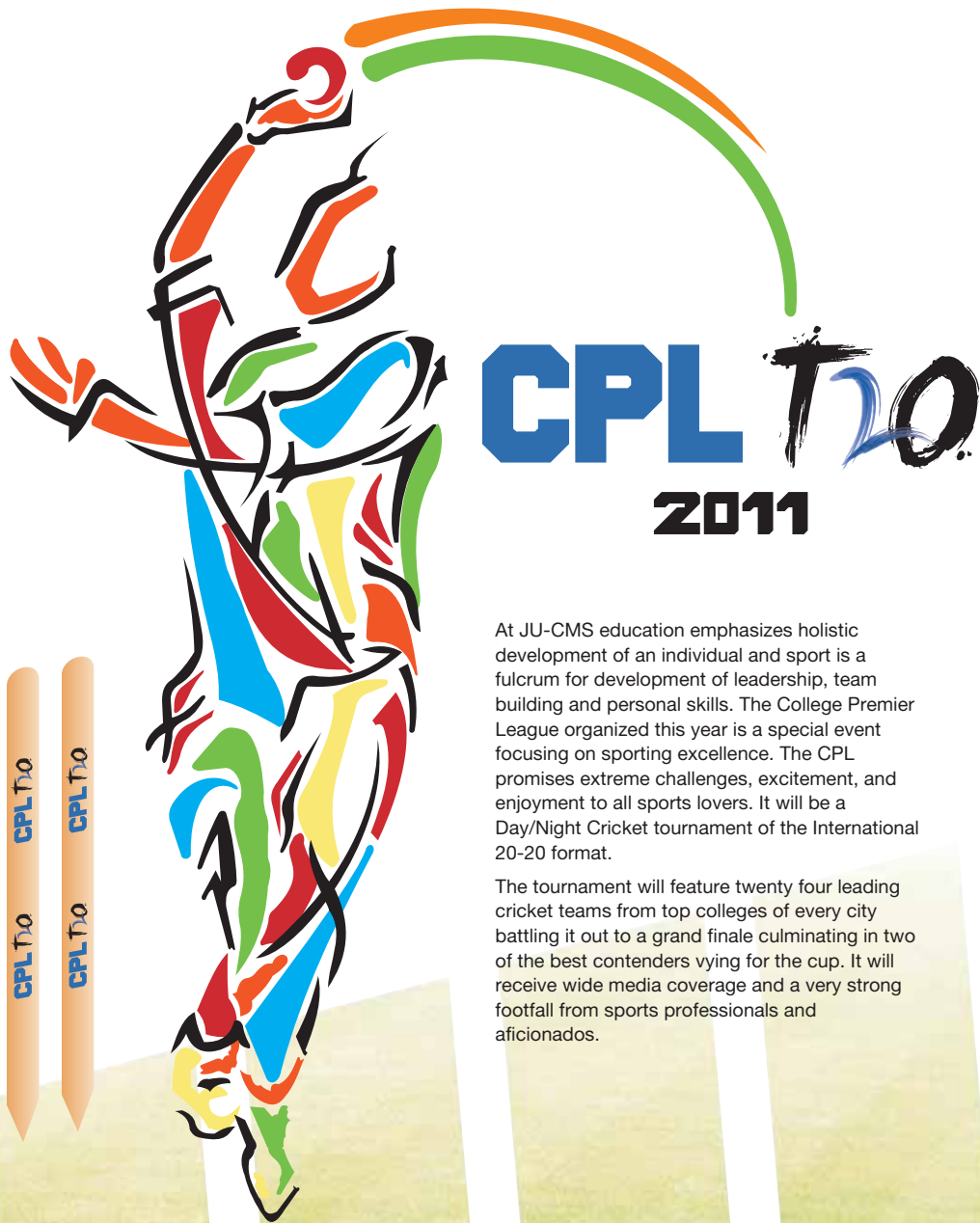

The College Premier League organized this year is a special event focusing on sporting excellence. The CPL promises extreme challenges, excitement, and enjoyment to all sports lovers. It will be a Day/Night Cricket tournament of the International 20-20 format.

The tournament will feature twenty four leading cricket teams from top colleges of every city battling it out to a grand finale culminating in two of the best contenders vying for the cup. It will receive wide media coverage and a very strong footfall from sports professionals and aficionados.

Rules & Regulations:

The following guidelines will govern the matches in the tournament.

- This tournament is approved by Karnataka State Cricket Association (KSCA).
- This leather ball tournament is of 20 overs only for each side. The semi-finals and finals will be day/night matches.
- Colleges / Institutions are eligible to participate in CPL by invitation only.
- The registration form can be downloaded from the website – www.cms.ac.in
- Please confirm your participation to **Mr. Chand Pasha, 09741988470**. You can also give your confirmation by E-mail : cpl.cms@jainuniversity.ac.in
- All forms duly filled along with College name, player's name, class in which he is studying, date of birth, phone numbers, and faculty / coach name should be submitted to Jain University - CMS on or before 17th August, 2011.
- There will be a meeting on CPL with the captains and coaches on 27th of August 2011. Rules and Regulations will be briefed on the same day. Draws will be done on lottery basis.
- No changes will be entertained.
- All teams are required to bring along their kit. However, if a basic kit is required it will be provided by JU-CMS.
- KSCA approved red balls will be used and provided for the first two sets of matches. Teams will be provided with white balls from the league stage.
- Cricket is an art and calls for discipline. Smoking, Alcohol, Gutka and Tobacco is strictly prohibited. Late entry to the venue on the day of the match is not allowed.
- Jain University - CMS welcomes guests of all teams but the right of admission is left to the discretion of the host college.
- Accommodation is on twin sharing or triple sharing basis. Smoking and drinking in the room is strictly prohibited. Out station teams are not supposed to bring their family members for stay.
- Use of Mobile phones during the duration of the match is prohibited.
- Each Institution / Group is permitted to send only one team.
- College will take care of accommodation, travel (Sleeper Class student concessional fare Indian Railways only), and food for the outstation participants. Submission of the ticket (photo copy) is a must for reimbursement.
- Travel, accommodation and food will be provided for 14 members of the outstation team only. Additional members can be accommodated at the expense of the participating team provided prior information with exact numbers is given.
- All travel reservation must be done by the participant. Only student concessional railway fare will be reimbursed by JU-CMS.
- All students should carry a valid college ID card while traveling.
- Reimbursement will be provided only to teams which remain at the hotel as participants from 17th Sept. evening to 26th Sept. morning.
- If a team wishes to leave Bangalore at an earlier date reimbursement will not be provided by JU-CMS.
- The Head of the Institution/Group should certify the players and all the participants should carry a valid ID Card.
- The tournament has total cash prizes amounting to Rs.1.5 lakhs and above (considering all the clusters of matches)
- There will also be individual prizes for each match :
 - Man of the Match
 - Best Catch
 - Best Bowler
 - Best Batsman
- Man of the series – Car or a motorcycle (Conditions apply) The winner will be solely responsible for transportation and registration of the vehicle with all incumbent responsibilities.
- The tournament awards cash prizes to the winning team at each round. Each player of the winning team shall be awarded with:
 - Rs. 300/- for the 1st Round
 - Rs. 500/- for the 2nd Round
 - Rs. 600/- for the League Round
 - Rs. 1000/- for the Semi-Final
 - Rs. 2000/- for the Final
- All participants will receive participation certificates.
- The entry fee for the tournament is Rs. 2,000/- only. DD should be in favour of “**Center for Management Studies**” payable at Bangalore.
- All the players are insured for the tournament. Basic medical assistance will be provided. However, if by any chance a sportsman is seriously injured JU-CMS is not responsible for any mishap. The expenditure other than the insured amount will be borne by the sportsman and not by JU-CMS.
- Full time physiotherapist and a fitness trainer will be available for every match.

Venue:

- All Knockout and the league matches are scheduled to be held at St John's Medical College Ground, Hosur Road, Koramangala 2nd Block, Koramangala, Bangalore
- Semi-Finals and Finals are scheduled to be held at the NRA Grounds, Jayamahal Extn., Bangalore

Timings & Schedule:

- The teams are required to report at least 45 minutes before the commencement of their respective matches. KSCA approved balls will be given by the organizers.

Fielding Restrictions:

- There shall not be more than 5 fielders on the leg side.
- For the first 6 overs of each innings, only two fielders are permitted to be outside the thirty-yard circle.
- For the remaining overs of each innings, only five fielders are permitted to be outside the thirty-yard circle.

Number of Over's per bowler:

- All matches including the final will be on 20/20 basis. A minimum of 5 bowlers shall be used, subject to maximum of 4 overs per bowler.

Attire:

- The captains are required to ensure that all the players in their respective teams are in whites for the knockout stages.
- The teams that qualify for the League stages will be provided with colored jerseys by the organizers which will be chosen only by lottery system.

Laws:

- No Ball: The front foot overstepping no ball penalty will be one run and an extra ball shall be bowled in the over. The preceding delivery will be a "free hit" wherein the batsmen cannot be dismissed except by being run out.
- The fielding captain is not allowed to change the position of his fielders except for the case that the batsmen have crossed during the front foot overstepping no ball delivery.
- Wide Ball: The wide ball penalty will be one run and an extra ball shall be bowled in the over.
- Timed Out: The incoming batsman must be in position to receive the next ball within 60 seconds of the fall of the previous wicket.
- Time Wasting Penalties: If the umpire considers the batsman to be un-necessarily wasting time, one warning will be given in an innings. The second time that the umpire deems a batsman wasting time, and for every subsequent instance thereafter, 6 runs shall be added to the total of the fielding side.
- Over rate: The team fielding will have to bowl 20 overs in 80 minutes after which a 10-minute mid-innings break will follow. In case the team does not complete the overs in the allotted time, penalty runs at the rate of 6 runs per over bowled short will be awarded to the batting team.

- Only undergraduate students are eligible to play in the tournament. (First year degree to Final year degree)
- All the players should possess valid ID Cards and produce the same along with the team declaration before the commencement of the match.
- If a team fails to report on time, a walkover will be awarded to the opponent team.
- Playing 11 will have to be chosen from a list of 14 players submitted along with the entry form and no changes in the squad of 14 members will be entertained later.
- In case of a tie or abandonment of a match due to rain or any other reason, the result of the match will be arrived at adopting the method in the 20/20 cricket, namely, SUPER OVER. At the end of a tied or abandoned match and before the Super Over, each team nominates three batsman and a bowler. The team that scores the most runs in its Super Over is the winner of the match. If the scores in the Super Over are tied, the match is won by the team that has scored the most 6s in their innings.
- If a match except finals is abandoned without a ball being bowled, the winners will be declared as per the details given above.
- A match will be considered abandoned if either side has not batted for a minimum of 6 overs. The winners will be declared on the basis of "SUPER OVER".
- If no play is possible, the winner will be decided on the basis of "toss of coin" in the knockout stages, whereas points will be shared in the league stages
- If the play is not possible in the finals on the scheduled day, the match will be rescheduled, the details of which will be intimated later.
- The standard 20/20 international rules will apply under all circumstances.
- In an emergency, the organizing committee reserves the right to take decision without consulting the teams. No protest in this regard will be entertained.
- Umpires decision is final. No arguments will be entertained on this.





Format of the Tournament

- The tournament will consist of 24 teams.
- The first two rounds of the tournament will be played on a knockout basis from which 6 teams will qualify for the League stages.
- Swapping of matches is not permitted. However, for administrative convenience organizers may do so.
- The detailed format with respect to match dates is given below
