CMS Festival

► The 'CMS Festival', which is an amalgamation of four major national festivals, is to be hosted by Jain University from January 6 to February 2. The festival includes 'Abhinaya', 'Threshold', 'Lasya' and 'Precipice'. 'Abhinaya 2012', the annual national-level theatre festival, organised by Jain University, will be held from January 6 to 8 at JSS Auditorium, Jayanagar 8th block. It is a competition of short



plays in Kannada and Hindi and is open for corporates, colleges and amateur theatre groups from across India. The teams will enact original or adapted short plays of minimum 40-minute duration during the competition. The winner from

each category will get Rs 1 lakh as cash prize in addition to the trophy. The teams, which have qualified in the national-level preliminary rounds, will be presenting their plays on January 6, 7 and 8. There are also attractive prizes for best direction, actor (male and female), set design, lighting and costumes. Entry is free. For details, call M K Srinivasa on 9449525457. 'Threshold', which is the first-year management festival, has been organised exclusively for the BBM students. It includes a series of competitions

and events which are structured in an unconventional format, and is to be held on January 31. 'Lasya', which is the cultural festival, is to be held on February 1 and 2. It includes several different cultural programmes, and is the perfect opportunity for students to display their creativity and explore their freedom of expression. 'Precipice' is a week-long extravaganza, which takes place in Milan, Italy. This festival, which is to be held between February 18 and February 23, is meant for management students.
