Precipice is an international management fest, planned and executed as a student initiative by the students of Jain University - Center for Management Studies. Over the years, it has traversed the globe giving students a rich cultural experience. Participants include members of prestigious B Schools across India, who have qualified for the finale of Precipice.

### **BRIEF ITINERARY:**

**Destination : Australia (Gold Coast, Melbourne & Sydney)**

**Date :** 1<sup>st</sup> Feb – 11<sup>th</sup> Feb 2018

If you have a choice of group, kindly book together.

- 3 nights – Gold Coast
- 3 nights – Melbourne
- 3 nights – Sydney

### **RULES & REGULATIONS:**

1. Every student must have a valid passport as on **25/9/2017**. The passport must remain **valid till at least 30/08/2018**, without which booking will not be accepted.
2. Original passport and 2 sets of photocopy of the passport 1<sup>st</sup> page (photo & name) & last page (address page) is a must for booking.
3. Passport should have at least 5 empty pages for visa & immigration stamping.
4. Passport must not be damaged or hand written (eg: soiled pages, damage due to water, oil, food etc)
5. Only eligible students can book a seat for Precipice 2018. List of eligible students will be put up on the notice board on 25/09/2017.
6. A copy of the following documents must **COMPULSORILY** be provided, without which bookings will not be accepted.
  - Valid Passport
  - PAN Card (personal or belonging to your parent/guardian / sponsor)
7. Bookings can be made in cash or demand draft. All demand drafts must be in favor of "Jagadish Air Travels (P) Ltd" payable at Bangalore. The official tour organizer is Jagadish Air Travels, No. 124, Brigade Road, Opp. Brigade Towers, Bangalore – 560025.
8. Seats will be provided on a first come, first serve basis.
9. Bookings will open on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2017 at 1:30pm sharp in Seminar Hall 3.
10. The opening price will be INR. 1,83,000 + Australian Visa + Tax (5%) + Insurance (Visa charges Rs. 9000/- as on 1/9/2017 visa fees subject to revision periodically due to ROE fluctuation).
11. You need not carry any food items with you.
12. You will be allowed to book a seat for another individual. However, you can book only one slot at a time, after which you will have to rejoin the queue for the subsequent booking. This shall not be valid for the first 25 slots.
13. Payment in installments is accepted. However, 50% has to be the initial installment and thereafter the payment will be in accordance with the prevailing rate on the date of balance payment. (No installment facility for the first 25 seats)

**Non-transferable:** All bookings for the trip are non-transferable and non-endorsable.

**Cancellation / Refund Policy:** Once a booking is made against a confirmed advance towards the trip – no cancellation can be made, no refund is payable in part or full against such cancellation irrespective of the reasons.

*In an unforeseen emergency such as viral outbreak (eg: Ebola), political disturbance etc., where the trip has to be cancelled, international regulations of refund will apply and if this strikes very close to the date of travel then refund will not be possible.*

If for any reason, visa is rejected:

- Within 30 days of the date of booking - 50% of the ticket charges and land package will be deducted, along with full visa charges
- Between 30 to 45 days – 60% of the ticket charges and land package will be deducted, along with full visa charges
- Above 45 days - 75% of the ticket charges and land package will be deducted, along with full visa charges
- In case of cancellation due to any other reason:
  - Within 30 days of date of booking - 50% of the ticket charges and land package will be deducted. Visa charges will not be deducted in case visa has not been applied for.
  - Between 30 days to 45 days – 60% of the ticket charges and land package will be deducted, along with full visa charges
  - Above 45 days - 75% of the ticket charges and land package will be deducted, along with full visa charges or international refund policy for groups whichever is applicable.
  - 15 days prior to date of travel 100% cancellation (no refund) Please note that refund will not be given for any reason, personal or otherwise 15 days prior to the date of travel
- All refund, if any, will be made only after the completion of the tour.

This being an organized package tour, no deviation from the itinerary or extension of tour will be entertained.

In the event of special cases, students will be permitted based on the following conditions:

- That prior permission must be sought with both parents appearing personally to the Principal.
- That such permission can be obtained in writing. Phone, Fax & email will NOT be entertained.
- Students will have to buy a completely new ticket (onward & return both). Plus, any visa, insurance charges will be borne by them for the return journey.
- Any deviation will be allowed only on the last day of “organized Precipice trip” i.e, after the organized trip is completed.
- You have to give a photocopy of the onward & return ticket booked by you. Permission will be given to you based on your academic attendance in college.
- The management reserves the right to grant or not grant such deviations from the agenda at its sole discretion.
- No cancellation or swapping of tickets / package will be allowed.
- Cancelled seats will go vacant, and no barter of such tickets will be allowed.
- Non-Jainites will not be allowed on this trip.
- Other than India, countries like Nepal, Bangladesh and others have their respective visa charges. The same will be applicable if necessary. Visa could be a challenge for Students from Nepal, Bangladesh, Afghanistan etc.
- Due to any reason if you have to fly back to India, you have to buy your own return flight ticket in addition to all the other expenses incurred in flying you back to India.
- If relatives & friends wish to meet with you, they should come to the hotel and meet, with the permission from the teacher. **Overnight stay at the relatives place will not be entertained.**
- Regarding exchange rate fluctuation during crisis, students are requested to co-operate with the difference if any.
- Selection of flight carriers is done on random basis and students should note that the decision of the college is final and binding.
- Safety during water sports and on the complete tour is the sole responsibility of each student.
- Smoking, consumption of alcohol or any other banned substance in any form is strictly prohibited and misbehavior will not be tolerated.
- Any damage caused to the property of the hotel by the occupant of an allotted room will have to be fully reimbursed by the occupants of the room.
- Please carry specific medicines prescribed by your doctor, with a valid prescription.

### **POINTS TO NOTE:**

- 1 Australian Dollar – INR 52/- (INR Fluctuating, Kindly look into the days rate).
- Time difference – Australia – 4:30hrs ahead of India
- Weather forecast – (22) to (25) degree Celsius
- Hotel Rooms on twin or triple sharing basis
- Normal Standard Vegetarian food will be provided
- **It is mandatory to attend the Precipice finale. Dress Code:** Formals with blazer.

### **VISA DOCUMENTS:**

- All passports should be Valid till **30<sup>th</sup> August 2018**.
- Notarized copy of full passport (including blank pages). All passports including all the old and new passports have to be notarized.
- College ID card
- Copy of Academic certificates (10<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> & latest available semester marks card copy)
- Passport copies or election card copies of both parents to confirm signatures.
- Request from the parents for the visa & a parent consent form. (Letter will be mailed to you).
- Parents proof of occupation (if business – business registration certificate etc, if employed – company appointment letter & 3 months salary slip with seal & signature of employer / HR)
- Latest 3yrs Income tax returns (ITR) filed proof of the Parents with computation (P&L A/c, B/S)
- 6 month bank statement with minimum Rs.1,50,000/- balance and also good transactions (approx. Rs. 2,00,000, seal & signature of the Bank manager on all pages).
- A specific date & time will be given to each student to fill the Australian visa application form at the computer lab. Kindly stick to the date and time.
- A specific date and time will be given to each student for the visa submission at Bangalore, which cannot be changed.
- Any other document requested by the consulate General has to be submitted.
